How to complete your membership application

1. Application for

Specify if the application is for membership or if you're transferring from a different unemployment insurance fund. If you've worked abroad, specify whether you're currently working in Sweden or if you're unemployed. Contact AEA Utland for further information.

2. Work requirement

To fulfil the work requirement you need to be working in Sweden. You also fulfil the work requirement if your most recent employment was in Sweden. Specify employer you work or have worked for.

Are you self-employed? Specify the name of your company and corporate identification number.

3. Education/Academic requirement

To fulfil the academic requirement you need to have acquired a minimum of 180 credits from a university or similar institution of higher education (equivalent to 3 year full time studies). Students are also eligible to join but must be currently studying towards 180 credits. If necessary, foreign qualifications can be validated by the The Swedish Council for Higher Education (UHR). You can also apply for membership if you're a member of one of the Saco unions (Swedish Academics Organisation) or Vårdförbundet.

Conditions for membership

In order to become a member of AEA you must fulfil both the academic and work requirement.

Assuming the required conditions are met, membership will be granted from the first day of the month in which AEA receives your application. You should therefore apply as soon as you begin working in Sweden.

Transfer

If you are transferring your membership in another unemployment fund, you need to contact your current fund and terminate your membership with them. Send in your membership application to AEA at the same time.

We can assist you in cancelling your membership if you fill a power of attorney (Fullmakt) and send the original copy to us as soon as possible. We will make sure that your membership is transferred to AEA, and there is no need for you to contact your current unemployment fund.

Membership fee

For your membership to be valid, you must pay the membership fee. The fee is SEK 90 per month.
